Scholarship Information

Society of Manufacturing Engineers, Nashville Chapter #43 is offering scholarship funds to its current membership and their families as well as active members of student chapter #S239 (MTSU), #S215 (TTU) and #S252 (APSU) and other engineering students as selected by the scholarship committee. A total of \$7,500 will be disbursed as scholarships to qualifying persons for the 2003/2004 school year. There will be 5 scholarships of \$1,500 each available this year.

EDUCATION PURPOSES

The money shall be used for post high school education in a manufacturing curriculum.

CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

1. Status of applicant.
 - a) Member of Nashville Chapter #43
Or
 - b) Legal relative of Chapter #43 member (e.g.; son, daughter, grandchild, nephew or niece.
Or
 - c) Member of Student chapter #S239 (MTSU) or #S252 (APSU) or #S215 (TTU)
 - d) Other engineering students as selected by the scholarship committee
2. The appropriateness of the educational program relative to the purpose of the Society of Manufacturing Engineers.
3. Minimum 3.0 GPA (on a 4 point scale) accumulative for the last two semesters.
4. The applicant must be a full time student (12 credit hours minimum)
5. The applicant must have completed a minimum of one academic year of post high school education.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

1. An application form must be filed with the scholarship committee of SME Nashville Chapter #43.
2. The applicant will be notified in writing of the committee decision related to his/her application.
3. The scholarship funds will go to the scholarship office of the appropriate educational institution to be allocated only for tuition.
4. If awarded scholarship funds, the applicant agrees to participate in any awards ceremonies as scheduled by the SME chapter(s) and/or the appropriate educational institution.
